SATURDAY – 15 May:

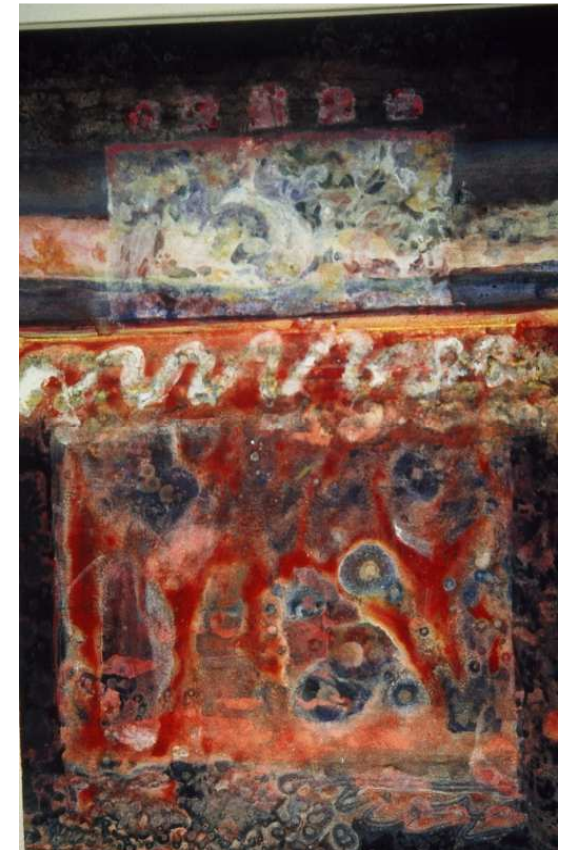
- Individualism (how each person has a unique gift of vision to offer)
